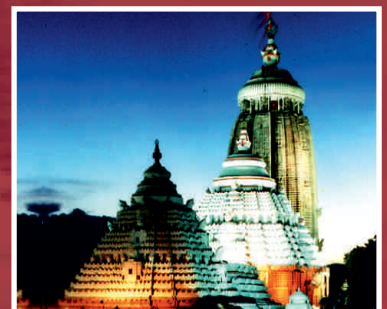
Konark Sun Temple
